Expenses before arrival and after drop-off at Windhoek Airport are the hunters' responsibility. Not included is dipping, packing, & shipping of trophies home, gratuities for PH and staff, and curios.

Pickup and drop-off are at Windhoek Airport, Windhoek, Namibia.

Cody Kuck (pronounced Cook) has generously donated a 4-Day/5-night rifle hunt for one hunter for one Mule Deer in the sandhills of Scottsbluff, Nebraska. Bucks will range from 160" - 190" and shots will be 150-350 yards depending on the hunter's comfort zone. Schedule your hunt for open dates during the 2021-2022 season. *The buyer of this hunt donation must bring another paying hunter to join him/her for the same hunt package at a cost of \$6500 per hunter.* As this is a rifle hunt, 90% of the time spent hunting is by spot and stalk by glassing in hunting areas from side-by-sides/UTVs or pickups. This 2x1 (unless booked otherwise) guided hunt can be from ground blinds over water sources or in fields where deer are feeding in cut cornfields or winter wheat fields.

Hunt includes field transportation to/from the lodge to your blind with your guide maintaining cell/walkie-talkie contact with you during the hunt. Also included is skinning, caping, and deboning of all big game animals for legal transportation to the taxidermist and/or processor. All meals, beverages (alcohol not included), snacks in the blind and lodging are included.

Hunters may drive to the ranch; however, pickup and delivery back to the Scottsbluff Airport can be provided. Nonhunters are welcome at \$150 per nonhunter per day. Not included are any before and after hunt expenses, permits/tags/licenses/stamps for the state hunted, processing fees, taxidermy fees and gratuities for your guide.

Based out of Bertrand, Nebraska, Cody has been able to expand his outfitting operation into two separate camps in Nebraska and two additional camps in Kansas offering in excess of 250,000 acres on which to hunt Merriam, Rio Grande, Eastern & Hybrid Turkey, Whitetail Deer, Mule Deer, Antelope, Elk (residents only), Prairie Dogs, Upland Birds (Pheasants & Quail) as well as predators (Coyote, Bobcat, and Mountain Lion)!
