Sam Monarch Memorial Four-Year Youth Scholarship

<u>Mission:</u> While KYSCI promotes SCI's Mission Statement that calls upon each of us to be "a leader in protecting the freedom to hunt & in promoting wildlife conservation" our main focus is on our youth & humanitarian services.

<u>Four-Year Scholarships:</u> Each year one outstanding KYSCI affiliated students entering college shall be awarded a scholarship valued at a total of \$2500 which will be distributed pro rata (proportionally) at the beginning of each semester over the four-year period of time.

Student selection is based upon merit involving the application requirements listed below:

Application Requirements:

- 1. Be committed to the sustainable use of natural resources and the roll of our hunting heritage
- 2. Be able to provide a certification of enrollment to an accredited college prior to the pro rata share of the award being distributed each semester
- 3. Show documented academic ability: applicant need not be at the top of his/her class but must have demonstrated a capacity to succeed in a chosen course of study
- 4. Provide three letters of recommendation from teachers, counselors, and/or employment/volunteer experience leaders clearly outlining applicant's strengths and/or weaknesses
- 5. Provide a copy of your hunter safety certificate (Hunter Orange Card)
- 6. Submit a properly completed KYSCI Sam Monarch Memorial Scholarship Application
- 7. Provide a current resume to include:
 - Community service and school activities (include leadership and volunteer activities)
 - Work experience
- 8. Submit a 500 word essay describing:
 - His/her commitment to conservation
 - How past experiences (life experience, volunteer or paid work, and academic accomplishments support your career goals
 - His/her hunting and fishing activities that demonstrate a pro-hunting viewpoint of wildlife management and wise land use ethics
- 9. Not have any record of being convicted of a Felony or a Class A Misdemeanor

Letter of acceptance to the college
Official copy of your high school transcripts
Three letters of recommendation and applicant appraisal forms
A current resume
A 500-word essay
A copy of your hunter safety certificate (Orange Card)
If you are a KYSCI Chapter member include a letter of recommendation from the chapter. If you are not a SCI
Chapter member a letter is not required
