Hunt includes the trophy fee for one Game Estate SCI Silver Medal Red Stag, daily fees, personal guide, pick up & return to Blenheim Airport, accommodation with personal ensuite, exquisite views & traditional meals during your stay. Not included are before & after pick up/drop off expenses & costs associated with trophy export. **The successful bidder must purchase a Fallow Stag (US \$3,500).**

Hunt is upgradable to a SCI Gold, Super Gold or bigger Red Stag by using the donation value of US \$5,500.00 as a credit toward the published trophy fees. Also available are trophy quality Fallow Deer, Arapawa Rams, Wild New Zealand Goats, Wild Boar – all available at published trophy fees. Also, if requested, Steve & Shirley will work with the hunter to set up a Himalayan Tahr hunt (with/without helicopter) at an additional cost.

Additional hunting days may be added at US \$500 per hunter per day. Non-hunting observers are welcome at US \$200 per observer per day, which includes transfers to and from Blenheim Airport, meals,



accommodation and light refreshments. Additional hunters may be added at a daily rate of US \$500 per hunter per day; however, should a hunter take a trophy over the value of US \$3,000 then the daily rate may be waived.

Clarence Valley offers many tourist attractions. Shirley can organize whale watching, dolphin swimming, river rafting, Marlborough wine tasting, golfing on Kaikoura's magnificent course, or visiting the local shops in Kaikoura (¾ hour drive) or shopping in Blenheim (1 ½ hours drive) or fresh water fishing in season.

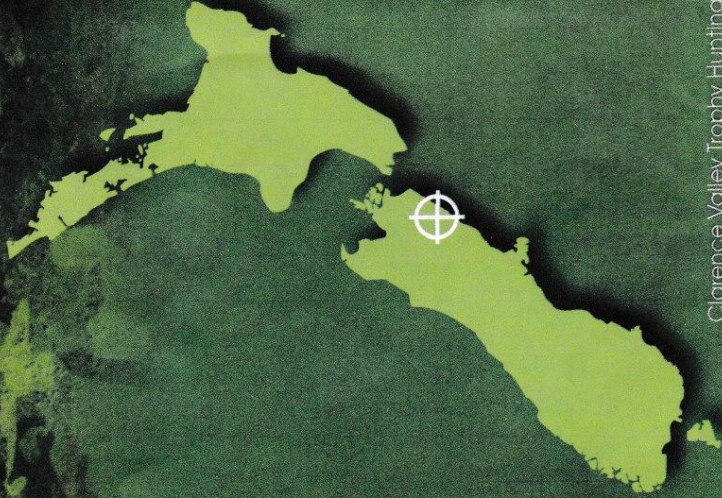
Clarence Valley

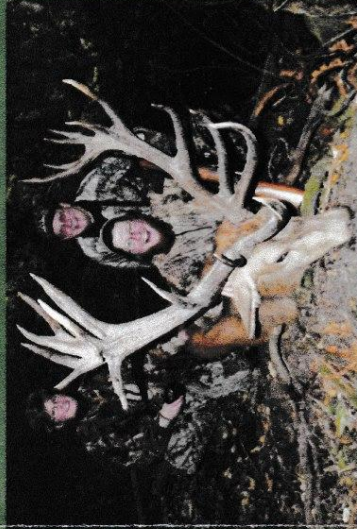
Tahr (Tahr)

One of New Zealand's most prestigious big game animals, they live at high altitude in the Southern Alps. Tahr can be hunted from the end of April until the end of July.



Chamois

Chamois have amazing eyesight which makes for a challenging hunt. We recommend they are hunted from April until July because of their full winter coat at that time. Chamois are normally hunted in conjunction with Tahr.



Red Stag

New Zealand is renowned for the finest red deer stags in the world and priding ourselves on quality. Clarence Valley is no exception. Red stags can be hunted from late March until early August with April/May being the best time.

Hunting at Clarence Valley

Privately owned, Clarence Valley is available for your party's own exclusive use during your hunting trip. Bow or rifle, we welcome all hunters, regardless of fitness and we do our utmost to ensure your satisfaction.

New Zealand Wapiti (Elk)

Wapiti are hunted in the same areas as Red Stag and Fallow. They can be hunted from late March until early August.

Wild New Zealand Rams (Arapawa Rams)

Most hunters take these as an extra trophy with their thick spiral horns and brown/black skins they make a wonderful wall mount and can be hunted all year round.

Wild New Zealand Goats and Boars

We have a number of excellent trophy goats and Boars roaming the park. They also come in a unique range of colours and can be hunted all year round.

Bow Hunting

Bow hunters are very welcome at Clarence Valley. Many take advantage of the "one hunting party at a time" practice as this ensures undisturbed animals within the park, thus giving you the best chance to successfully secure one of the many quality trophy animals available.
